Tuition model: Primary Drivers

Student-friendly

- Transparent and predictable cost
- Improve retention, time to graduation and graduation rates
 - Encourage students to enroll in full course loads
 - Provide opportunity to reduce cost with faster graduation

Flexible, competitive pricing

 New model provides greater flexibility to adjust rates due to market conditions

Tuition model: Key Changes for Undergraduates

- Move from base tuition plus course fees and IT fees to a flat tuition by program (major)
- Plateau rates for 12-18 hours per semester
 - Resident
 - Non-resident
- Three tiers
 - Tier 1 Freshmen rate, Humanities/Math/Education/
 - Tier 2 Lab Sciences/Business/IST/Economics/Engineering Management
 - Tier 3 Engineering/Computing

Student Success Initiatives Underway

- Curriculum review
 - Streamline degree programs (eliminate roadblocks and unnecessary prerequisites)
 - Ensure all coursework is truly needed
- Accelerated retakes
- Focus on high DFW 1000 level course redesign
- Mental Well-Being Ambassador Certification
- Early intervention with periodic grade checks
- Enhanced tutoring and LEADs
- Enhanced, targeted peer mentoring
- Targeted summer programming (possibly discounted)
- Increased Advising touchpoints
